LERWICK HARBOUR – SUBSEA PIPE INSTALLATION

Tulloch Developments Ltd will be carrying out operations to install a subsea water pipe between Lerwick and Bressay.

The route of the subsea pipe runs from approximate shore coordinates:
60° 10.495'N 001° 09.285'W at the Point of Scattland, Lerwick to;
60° 10.537'N 001° 08.852'W north Heogan, Bressay.

Marine operations will commence on Friday 2nd July 2010 and are expected to be complete by 13th August 2010.

Throughout this period the main buoyed channel in the vicinity will remain in operation to all vessels, smaller vessels should also utilise the main channel through this period.

There is expected to be minor disruption to the main buoyed channel for a period of a few hours through the day on Sunday 4th July.

Operations will be carried out from the vessel 'Skelda Lass' who will display lights and shapes in accordance with the amended Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collision) Regulations 1996, and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Marine Channels 12 & 16.

There will be diving operations and personnel may be working at sea level throughout the construction period.

Mariners are requested to contact Port Control, pass at slow speed and give a wide berth when transiting the area.
