



NOTICE to MARINERS

LERWICK HARBOUR DREDGING – PHASE 2B

This notice is to supplement NtM 04/26 with additional temporary information.

Mariners are advised that works will continue to deepen and widen the entrances to Lerwick Harbour (centred at 60° 09.9' N 001° 9.2' W)

Passages through the channels will be restricted at times and buoyage will be temporarily removed from the channels as required to facilitate the dredging work.

Vessels may be directed to utilise a single entrance to Lerwick while works progress at the respective channel.

The vessels involved will display lights and shapes in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collision) Regulations 1996 and a maintain a listening watch on VHF Marine Channels 12 & 16.

Passing vessels are required to contact Port Control and keep well clear.
