### **LERWICK HARBOUR DREDGING – PHASE 2B**

Mariners are advised that commencing on or around 7<sup>th</sup> June for a period of up to 4 months, dredging operations will take place initially within Dales Voe (centred at 60° 11.6' N 001° 10.6' W) and then subsequently within the North Harbour of Lerwick (centred at 60° 09.9' N 001° 9.2' W).

Vessels involved will include:

These vessels will operate 24 hours per day, seven days per week and will move regularly, in various locations undertaking seabed treatment for future widening and deepening at the port.

All of the vessels involved will display lights and shapes in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collision) Regulations 1996 and a maintain a listening watch on VHF Marine Channels 12 & 16.

During certain periods, restrictions may apply to the movement of vessels in the vicinity. Passing vessels are requested to contact Port Control and keep well clear.
