



**NOTICE to MARINERS**

**LERWICK HARBOUR DREDGING**

Mariners are advised that commencing on or around 16<sup>th</sup> June for a period of up to 5 months, dredging operations will take place within the North Harbour of Lerwick (centred at 60° 09.9' N 001° 9.2' W) and Dales Voe (60° 11.6' N 001° 10.6' W).

Vessels involved will include:

These vessels will operate 24 hours per day, seven days per week and will move regularly, dredging in various locations including widening and deepening channels at the port.

Dredged material will be deposited at a deposit site at the North Entrance, GPS Position: 60° 11.3' N 001° 7.6' W.

All of the vessels involved will display lights and shapes in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collision) Regulations 1996 and maintain a listening watch on VHF Marine Channels 12 & 16.

During certain periods, restrictions may apply to the movement of vessels in the vicinity. Passing vessels are requested to contact Port Control and keep well clear.
